Rev. Dr. Alfred Bloom, a Professor Emeritus at the University of Hawaii and a retired Kaikyoshi Minister of Honpa Hongwanji Mission of Hawaii, passed away on August 25, 2017. The Hawaii Kyodan-so Funeral Service was held on September 2, 2017 at Honpa Hongwanji Hawaii Betsuin under the officiation of Bishop Eric Matsumoto. The Ingo (Posthumous Title) of Ko-Toku-In 廣徳院 has been conferred upon Rev. Dr. Alfred Bloom by the Jodo Shinshu Hongwanji-ha Denomination in recognition of his exemplary achievements and accomplishments.
